## RMU Recognized for Reliable Electric Service

Rolla Municipal Utilities has received national recognition for achieving exceptional electric reliability in 2022. The recognition comes from the American Public Power Association (APPA), a trade group that represents more than 2,000 not-for-profit, community-owned electric utilities. RMU is in the top 25% of utilities for System Average Interruption Duration Index (SAIDI).

RMU is proud to receive this recognition. It is a testament to the hard work of all our staff to ensure that we keep the City of Rolla powered.

APPA helps electric utilities track power outage and restoration data through its subscription-based eReliability Tracker service. Once per year, APPA's Reliability Team compares this data to national statistics tracked by the U.S. Energy Information Administration for all types of electric utilities.

Are you ready? Summer is just around the corner. The weather is getting warmer, and that means it's time to start thinking about how you're going to prepare your air conditioner for summer. It's important to make sure your AC is in good working order so you can keep cool all summer long. Here are a few tips on how to prepare your air conditioner for summer.

First, start with the outdoor unit:

- 1. Remove any condenser covers, coil blankets or lids from the outdoor unit.
- 2. Inspect outdoor unit panels.
- 3. Remove debris.
- 4. Repair or replace any damaged pipe insulation.

Then, inspect the indoor unit:

- 1. Change the air filters.
- 2. Check the indoor condensate drain lines.
- 3. Clean the supply vents and return grills.

A brief inspection of your air conditioner now could help keep your system running smoothly during the summer months. A qualified technician can help you do a more thorough spring technical inspection to avoid a system failure in the hottest months of the year.
