This project is divided into two contracts. RMU RFB #24-119: LSLI Contract 1 - Excavations is to determine water service line material type through excavations at water meter pits. RMU RFB #24-120: LSLI Contract 2 - Visual Inspections is to determine water service line material type through visual inspections conducted around or within structures. While bidders may bid on only one contract or on both contracts, a separate Bid Proposal/Quotation Form will be required for each contract. Bid proposals developed using documents and specifications, or other information obtained from other sources may not be accepted. Electronic proposals will not be considered, even in cases where bid documents and specifications were obtained electronically from RMU. Proposals must be sealed and clearly labeled with the inquiring entity's name and address on the outside of the envelope. Proposals will be opened and read publicly at 10:00 a.m. Central Standard Time on July 30, 2024.
